Candidates attending counselling should satisfy the eligibility requirement as per the NEET Information Brochure 2020 and the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed by the Dental Council of India & for admission to UG Dental course.

Counseling Procedure:

A) Come prepared for Counselling:

The following original documents are to be submitted for verification during Counselling:

Documents Check Lists

- NEET Score Card
- NEET rank card
- NEET Hall Ticket/ Admit Card
- 10th standard marks card for proof of date of birth
- Marks card of 10 + 2
- 12th Pass Certificate
- Conduct and Character certificate obtained on the School/College letter head/pad. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
- Transfer Certificate or School/College Leaving Certificate issued by the School/College. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
- Fees: As applicable for the programme
- Two recent and identical passport size photographs
- One set of self-attested photocopies of all the above documents
- Aadhar Card Copy

NRI CANDIDATES NEED TO PRODUCE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

1. Affidavit of the person who is NRI and the sponsorer.
2. Documents claiming that the sponsorer is an NRI (Passport, Visa of the sponsorer)
3. Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. dated 22-08- 2017.
4. Affidavit from the sponsorer that he/ she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate.
5. Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer

IMPORTANT NOTE:

There will be active verification of the NEET All India Rank (UR) submitted by the candidate with the information available in the NEET website (cbseresults.nic.in). Candidate whose NEET all India rank does not match with the information in the NEET website will be disqualified for the counselling process.

B) On the day of Counselling:

The physical presence of the candidate at the counselling is mandatory.

- Only the candidate & one parent will be allowed into the counselling hall.
- Candidate should sign the attendance register to mark their presence.
- Full fee must be paid at the time of admission and request for extension will NOT be entertained.
- Candidates will be called as per their **NEET All India (UR) Rank 2020** for document verification. Successful candidates will be allotted seats according to their All India NEET (UR) rank and number of seats available. Such candidates should produce their original documents for verification and pay the first year fees at the time of counselling.

NOTE: Absence of the candidate at the indicated reporting time and date will result in the instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for a seat.

The number of candidates called for the counselling will be more than the total number of seats available. Mere call for counselling does not guarantee admission to a course. This will exclusively depend on the candidates All India Rank, the number of candidates attending the counselling and the number of seats available.

In case the seats in NRI quota fall vacant, then the same will be converted in to All India General category and counselling for such seats will done on inter-se merit.
